NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:


- 1) The Board shall hold a Public Hearing on Monday, October 20, 2008, at 9:30 o'clock in the morning, at the Board's premises, 15 Market Square, Suite 1400, Saint John, New Brunswick, whereby;

E5B 1B5, Tel: (506) 529-3101, Fax: (506) 529-4930, E-mail: hmstrans@nbnet.nb.ca and the Board at the address below, on or before Tuesday, October 14, 2008, setting out their choice of official language for the hearing and why the application should be denied.
- 3) A Notice in substantially the form attached hereto marked "A"
 - a) be served upon the Mayors of St. Andrews, St. Stephen, St. George and Saint John
 - b) be posted on the bus
 - c) be published, in the English and French language, once in each of the following newspapers:

St. Croix Courier	-	St. Stephen
Telegraph Journal	-	Saint John
