**NB POWER'S REQUEST FOR AN INCREASE TO
ELECTRICITY RATES**

The **New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power)** has applied to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) for approval of an average 2% increase in the rates it proposes to charge commencing April 1, 2017. The requested increases by customer class are listed as follows:

a. Residential	2.33 per cent
b. General Service I	0.90 per cent
c. General Service II	2.00 per cent
d. Small Industrial	2.00 per cent
e. Large Industrial	2.00 per cent
f. Wholesale	2.00 per cent
g. Other (rentals & fees)	2.00 per cent

The Board will hold a **Public Session** at which any member of the public may attend and comment on NB Power's application to increase electricity rates. This public session will be held on **Tuesday, January 24, 2017**, at the **Delta Fredericton**, 225 Woodstock Road, Fredericton, N.B. commencing at **6:00 p.m.**

Alternatively, anyone wishing to provide their comments in writing to the Board may do so by Monday, January 23, 2017.
