**IN THE MATTER** of an application by Enbridge  
Gas New Brunswick Inc. to amend its Permit to  
Construct 2000-1

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** Enbridge Gas New Brunswick Inc. (the “Applicant”) has applied to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities of New Brunswick (“Board”) pursuant to subsection 22(1) of the Gas Distribution Act, 1999 by application dated June 25, 2002 (the “Application”) to amend its Permit to Construct 2000-1 to allow it to construct high pressure, steel pipelines on Expansion Avenue, Old Black River Road, McIlveen Drive, Whitebone Way, Fairvale Blvd. and Connector Street, Saint John, New Brunswick (as shown on plans filed with the Application) in 2002 and to allow for further construction of high pressure polyethylene pipelines and high and extra-high pressure steel pipelines as part of its infill program in municipalities presently subject to permits to construct issued by this Board without the necessity of a further public hearing;

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. A pre-hearing conference shall be held at the Board’s office at 15 Market Square, Suite 1400, Saint John, New Brunswick on August 19, 2002 commencing at 10:00 o’clock in the forenoon, when and where the Applicant, intervenors and other interested parties should attend and make representations on the following:
  - (a) the type of proceeding to consider the Application;
  - (b) the procedure to be followed in respect of the proceeding; and
  - (c) any other matters in respect thereto.
  
2. Notice of the date for the holding of the pre-hearing conference in respect of the Application be published in the form or substantially in the form attached hereto marked

“A”, in either the English or French language as may be appropriate having regard to the principal language of publication, twice in each of the following newspapers:

The Moncton Times and Transcript	Moncton
L'Acadie Nouvelle	Caraquet
The Daily Gleaner	Fredericton
The Telegraph Journal	Saint John

once on or before July 5, 2002 and once between July 8, 2002 and July 12, 2002.

3. Persons intending to intervene must notify the Board and the Applicant, in writing, at the addresses below, no later than July 29, 2002 and:

- (a) state whether the person intends to appear at the pre-hearing conference and the official language in which the person wishes to be heard;
- (b) set out the name of the person and any authorized representative of the person and the mailing address, address for personal service, telephone number and any other telecommunications numbers of the person or the person's authorized representative; and
- (c) establish that the person's interest justifies intervenor status in the proceeding.

4. Persons who do not wish to formally intervene but who wish to make comments to the Board regarding the proceeding must notify the Board and the Applicant, in writing, at the addresses below, on or before July 29, 2002 of their intent to file a letter of comment, such letter to be sent to the Board and the Applicant no later than August 8, 2002.

5. Pursuant to subsection 96(3) of the Gas Distribution Act, 1999, the Applicant is exempted from the requirements of the Gas Distribution Rules of Procedure Regulation and the Gas Distribution and Marketers' Filing Regulation with respect to this Application.

6. The Application and additional information provided to the Board in support of the Application, together with a copy of this Order, be placed on file for examination by interested parties, during normal business hours, at the office of the Board in Saint John, NB, at the office of the Applicant in Fredericton, NB, at the municipal offices of the

Towns of St. George and Oromocto, NB, and at the office of GCP Bristol at 246 Lutz Street, Moncton, NB not later than 5:00 p.m. on July 5, 2002.
